Intellectual Output 3 – BECOME

Become an Expert on Mobility

Intellectual Output 3 (IO3) has been aimed at transforming results of Intellectual Output 1 (MAKE: Methodological Tool Kit Skills) and Intellectual Output 2 (MADE: Mobility Aimed Employability) into didactic tools, and more specifically, into a Massive Open Online Course (MOOC). The purpose of the MOOC has been to create a new high education qualification as “Method Expert for the Transparency and Validation of Learning Deriving from Mobility in Work-Based Learning”.

The MOOC is targeted to support the internationalisation of vocational education and training (VET) providers and

users. The participants of the MOOC, upon successful completion of the course, have been awarded a professional qualification.

The MOOC is entirely in English and freely accessible from everywhere in the world through Unitelma’s course website: elearning.unitelma.it.

The MOOC has been divided into four thematic areas, that will be presented more in detail on the next page of this document. These thematic areas are (1) Preparing Mobility, (2) Before Mobility, (3) During Mobility, (4) After Mobility.

Finally, the MOOC was validated through face-to-face laboratories.

Structure of the Massive Open Online Course

1. Preparing Mobility

This thematic module transfers abilities, competences, and essential knowledge, linked to learning outcomes and tailored for the mobility providers to better identify the training needs respect the National Qualification Framework of host and departure countries.

3. During Mobility

This thematic module provides tools and methodologies to design specific performance tests and/or interviews related to the nature of units of learning outcomes and link to National Qualification Frameworks qualification standards of host and departure countries.

2. Before Mobility

This thematic module provides methodologies to implement WBL abroad projects, aligned on unit/learning results and partial or full qualification referable to National Qualification Frameworks of host and departure countries.

4. After Mobility

This thematic module provides tools and methodologies to draw up a consistent validation document that complies with the national standards required by the National Qualification Frameworks (where the learning outcomes are appropriate) and preparatory to certification.

Final steps in the Mayfair project

Events

The Mayfair Joint Staff Training Event was held in Brussels, Belgium on 12-14 July 2022.

Face-to-Face Laboratories

The face-to-face laboratories were organised by partners mainly in August. The purpose of these laboratories was to test and validate the MOOC. Each partner was expected to test the MOOC on at least 20 learners.

Impact of MOOC

The impact of the MOOC was evaluated through an online questionnaire. The results of the questionnaire were used to produce a final report on the impact of the Mayfair MOOC.
